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ALLERGY NAME	CATEGORY	TYPICAL REACTION	NOTES
Penicillin	Drug	Hives, Anaphylaxis	Includes all penicillin-type antibiotics.
Peanuts	Food	Swelling, Anaphylaxis	Cross-reactivity with tree nuts possible.
Lidocaine Hydrochloride	Drug	Rash, Dizziness	Local anaesthetic allergy.
Sulfonamides	Drug	Rash, Steven-Johnson Syndrome	Includes Bactrim and Septra.
Aspirin / NSAIDs	Drug	Asthma, Hives	COX-1 inhibitor intolerance.
Shellfish	Food	Urticaria, Anaphylaxis	Includes shrimp, crab, lobster.
Latex	Latex	Contact Dermatitis, Anaphylaxis	Relevant for surgical glove exposure.
Bee Sting	Insect / Venom	Anaphylaxis, Swelling	Hymenoptera venom allergy.
House Dust Mites	Environmental	Rhinitis, Asthma	Perennial allergen.
Grass Pollen	Environmental	Hay Fever, Asthma	Seasonal exposure April to October.
Codeine / Opioids	Drug	Nausea, Respiratory Depression	May cross-react with morphine.
Dairy / Lactose	Food	GI Distress, Urticaria	Distinguish from lactose intolerance.
Contrast Dye (Iodinated)	Drug	Anaphylaxis, Nephrotoxicity	Pre-medicate with corticosteroid if needed.
Cat Dander	Animal	Rhinitis, Asthma	Fel d 1 protein is the main allergen.
Wasp Venom	Insect / Venom	Anaphylaxis, Local Swelling	Carry epinephrine auto-injector.
Tree Nuts	Food	Anaphylaxis, Oral Allergy	Includes almonds, cashews, walnuts.
Vancomycin	Drug	Red Man Syndrome, Anaphylaxis	Infusion rate-dependent reaction.
Methotrexate	Drug	Hepatotoxicity, Mucositis	Monitor LFTs regularly.
Eggs	Food	Urticaria, GI Distress	Common childhood allergy.
Mold Spores	Environmental	Rhinitis, Sinusitis	Peak exposure in wet and humid conditions.
